Entries should be on the Entry Form attached and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. The declaration on the form must be completed by the boat owner or his/her authorised representative and, if the owner is under 18 years of age, by his/her parent or guardian.

Entries close at 12 noon on Wednesday, May 26th, 2010. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Committee and only on payment of a €15 late entry fee.

The sailing instructions are common to the four waterfront regattas and will be circulated under the banner of the Dun Laoghaire Combined Clubs. Please retain for subsequent Club Regattas 2010.
