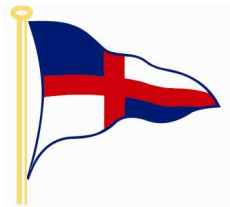

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NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising authority is the National Yacht Club

1. Rules

The series will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

2. Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to the following classes:-

Main Fleet - Optimist, Topper, Feva, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, 420.
Harbour Fleet – Optimist, Topper, Feva.

Boats may enter to race in either the Main Fleet or the Harbour Fleet. ISA Level 1 and 2 Competitors should enter the Harbour fleet.

Competitors must be 18 years of age or under on 31st December 2010.

Sails shall have the full sail number in accordance with the Class Rules of RRS.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it together with the required fee, to the Sailing Manager, National Yacht Club, Dun Laoghaire, Co. Dublin by **2pm on Tuesday 6th July 2010** by fax on : 01-2807837, or by email at sailing@nyc.ie.

Late entries may be accepted in exceptional circumstances by the Race Office in the National Yacht Club up to 9am on the day of racing at the discretion of the committee.

Registration will take place between 0800 and 0930 hrs in the race office and a briefing will be held at 09.30hrs.

3. Entry Fees

Single handed classes €15, double handed classes €25. This fee includes a barbecue after sailing.

4. Schedule

Launching for both fleets is scheduled to commence at 10.00hrs with the first warning signal for the Harbour fleet at 10.45 and the main fleet at 11.15. 3 races are scheduled.

The Harbour fleet will not race between 11.40 and 12.00 and 13.00 and 13.20 to facilitate the arrival and departure of the HSS (which all sailors shall keep clear of). Sailors should bring lunch and drinks afloat.

The Barbecue is scheduled to commence at 15.00 in the National YC, followed by prize giving.

Disco from 20.00 to midnight. Disco tickets (€5) may be purchased at registration by competitors only.

5. Venue and Courses

There shall be 2 courses. The course for the Main fleet will, subject to weather, be located in the Seapoint Bay area. The course for the Harbour Fleet will be in Dun Laoghaire Harbour. Course to be sailed shall be an Olympic Triangle.

6. Sailing Instructions

Copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the Series entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Series.

8. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,300,000 per event or the equivalent.
