### NOTICE OF RACE

- 1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The racing rules of sailing* and the prescriptions of the Irish sailing Association.
- 2 Advertising: Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3 Eligibility and Entry: Toppers using either the full or 4.2 rig are entitled to compete. All competitors must be fully paid up members of the Irish Topper Class Association.

- 4 Fees: €50 for entries received by 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2010. - Entry Fee: €60 for entries received thereafter.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2007 is 11.25hrs.  
The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2007 is 10.55hrs.
  - There will be 3 back to back races scheduled on each day.
  - Competitors are advised to bring their own lunch in a sealed package marked with their name and sail number.
  - Burgers will be available in the Club after sailing (included in entry fee for competitors).
- 6 Sailing instructions shall be available at Registration.
- 7 Visiting boats should be unloaded on the Carlisle Pier adjacent to the Club and taken into the Club on their launching trolleys. Visiting ribs should launch in the Coal Harbour at the western end of Dun Laoghaire Harbour and may be berthed at the National YC.
- 8 Prizes: Prizes shall be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and the 1<sup>st</sup> female. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, Prizes may be awarded for the 4.2M fleet depending on numbers (ratio 1:4). Prizes shall also be awarded in age categories. There shall be 3 categories depending on age as at 01.01.10, i.e. Under 12yrs Under 14yrs Under 16yrs. No sailor may win more than one prize.
- 9 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**  
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 10 **INSURANCE**  
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,300,000 per event or the equivalent.
