NOTICE OF RACE - Amendment No. 1

Issued 18th July 2011

(changes are shown in italics)

1.2 is amended to read as follows:

The Prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association to rules 5, 68, 86.3, and 88.2 shall apply.

They are as follows:

5 Anti-Doping

The ISA has adopted the World Anti-Doping Code. The Code is available from the ISA and is reproduced on the ISA's website, www.sailing.ie and on the ISAF website www.sailing.org.

68 Damages

No claims for damages arising from an infringement of any of the rules, as defined, shall be adjudicated upon by any protest committee or appeal authority but shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts.

86.3 Rule Changes

The written approval of the ISA is required for the implementation of rule 86.3.

88.2 Changes to National Authority Prescriptions

Notices of race and sailing instructions shall not change a prescription of the ISA. However, when an international jury has been appointed for an event, only the prescriptions to rules 5, 68, 86.3 and 88.2 shall apply.

3.2 is amended to read as follows:

Competitors *shall* only use one sail for the competition.

5.1 is amended to read as follows:

No entry fee is refundable after the *31st July 2011*.

12 is amended with the following addition:

Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a)

18 is amended with the following addition:

Competitors shall wear personal floatation devices at all times when afloat, except briefly when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal floatation devices. This changes rule 40.
