NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. The sailing instructions are common to all four waterfront regattas and will be circulated under the banner of the Dun Laoghaire Combined Clubs. (Please retain them for subsequent Club Regattas in 2012.)

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS.

3. ENTRY FEES.

Cruiser Class 3 (including Puppeteers) ECHO only €45 add IRC 2012 + €10

4. HANDICAPS and DIVISION of CLASSES.

Fleets will be divided on the following basis (subject to the committee's right to allocate a boat to any class):

White-Sail Cruisers shall conform to the DBSC class requirements.

Boats in other Cruiser Classes will be divided on the basis of their ISA Standard ECHO Reference Handicap.

Boats with ratings lower than minimum rating of the class above them may participate in that class but such boats shall accept the minimum rating of that class.

5. ASHORE

All Owners, Skippers and Crew will be Honorary Members of the NYC on the day of the Regatta. This privilege may be withdrawn at the discretion of the committee.

Prize giving will take place at approximately 1700.
