7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be e-mailed to those who entered online. Copies of the Sailing Instructions may be left in the Yacht Club designated on the entry form and will be available in the Race Office at the National Yacht Club.

8. Scoring

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. Penalties

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for Course B only.

10. Insurance

Each Boat's owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons. Boats or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain sufficient 3rd party insurance cover. All Owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

11. Liability

No responsibility shall be accepted by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, or any of the associated yacht clubs, their directors, officers, members servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the event, for

any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature, however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Regatta

12. Responsibility

The safety of the Boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge whose obligation it is to ensure that the Boat is fully sound, seaworthy and is manned by an experienced crew with all the required safety gear. Neither this Notice of Race nor the Sailing Instructions nor any action by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club and its Organising Committee in any way limits the responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge. Attention is drawn to RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rules.

13. Prizes

Prizes will be presented at the National Yacht Club at 18h00 approx for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd overall in each class (IRC and Echo for Cr0, Cr1, Cr2, & Cr3 handicapped fleets) subject to number of entries: up to 4 entries, only 1st Prize awarded; 5 entries 1st and 2nd Prizes will be awarded and 8 or more entries 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Prizes will be awarded. No boat shall win more than one prize.

Royal Alfred Trophies will be presented to Royal Alfred Members at the RAYC Annual Dinner on Friday 16th November in the National Yacht Club.
