

NYC Junior Regatta 2014 Wednesday 9th July



Notice of Race

1. Rules

The series will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

2. Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to the following classes: -

Main Fleet – Optimist, Topper, PY, Feva, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, 420, RS 200

Harbour Fleet – Optimist, Topper, Feva, PY

Boats may enter to race in either the Main Fleet or the Harbour Fleet. ISA Start Sailing, Basic Skills and First Year Improving Skills Competitors should enter the Harbour Fleet.

Competitors must be under 19 years of age on the 31st December 2014

Sails shall have the full sail number in accordance with the Class Rules of RRS.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form on the National Yacht Club website - www.nyc.ie

Late entries may be accepted by the Race Office in the National Yacht Club up to 09:00 on the day of racing on payment of an extra €10 fee.

Registration will take place from 08:00 - 09:00 on the morning of the Regatta at the NYC Race Office. Competitors briefing 09:15

3. Entry Fees

Single handed classes €15, Double handed classes €25. This fee includes a barbeque after sailing.

4. Schedule

Launching for both fleets is scheduled to commence at 10:00hrs with the first warning signal for the Harbour Fleet at 10:45 and the Main Fleet at 11:15. 3 races are scheduled.

The Harbour Fleet will not race between approximately 12:15 to 12:45 and 13:15 to 13:45 to facilitate the arrival and departure of the HSS (which all sailors will keep clear of). Sailors should bring lunch and drinks afloat.

The Barbeque is scheduled to commence at 15:00 in the National Yacht Club, followed by prize giving.

Disco from 19:00 to 10.30pm. Disco tickets (€5.00) may be purchased at registration by competitors only.

5. Venue and Courses

There shall be 2 courses. The course for the Main Fleet will, subject to weather, be located in the Seapoint Bay/ Scotsman Bay area of Dublin Bay. Course to be sailed shall be a Trapezoid Course. The course for the Harbour Fleet will be in Dun Laoghaire Harbour. Course to be sailed shall be a Triangular Course.

6. Sailing Instructions

Copies of the Sailing Instructions will be given at registration.

7. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the Series entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Series.

8. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000.00 per event or the equivalent.
